The news came out of the blue; I had cheek swabbed for Gift of Life over eight years ago in Camp Moshava. I felt lucky to have this opportunity to contribute toward saving a life. 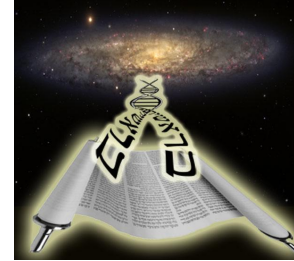
