
Pink Day Raises Thousands for Sharsheret

They heard from Mr. Steve Benvenisti, a local personal injury attorney, who described the case of a college student struck by a drunk driver

in Daytona Beach, Florida. He then revealed that he was the victim in the case. Officer Kerrington of the Teaneck Police Department then introduced a video, produced by Hackensack Medical Center, which reenacted a horrific car accident caused by a drunk teenage driver. The video was interspersed with personal accounts of parents and siblings of victims of drunk driving.
